The 2030 agenda for Sustainable Development adopted by all United Nations Member States in 2015, provides a shared blueprint for peace and


Together, these SDGs cover much of the problems we experience on earth. However, they do not cover the problem of landmines. There are calls from various quarters to develop an 18th SDG with the eradication of landmines as its subject.

### **Assignments**

Heidi Kuhn talked in the video about the importance of eradicating landmines. She advocates for an 18th SDG on this and asks for your help: what could this 18th SDG look like?

- 1. Go to the website (https://sdgs.un.org/goals) and study SDG 1 and 2. Both these SDGs have as their subject something that needs to disappear (poverty and hunger). Use this information as a blueprint for the 18th SDG: the eradication of landmines.
- 2. The image below shows the infographics of SDGs 1 and 2. Create a similar infographic for the 18th SDG: landmine eradication.
